## 2017 PENNSYLVANIA LIVESTOCK ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- \*\*A student may receive the Pennsylvania Livestock Association Scholarship award one time only.
- \*\*Application materials will not be returned and become the property of PLA Scholarship Committee.
- \*\*applicants who do not receive a scholarship are encouraged to apply in subsequent years.
- \*\*Each scholarship will have a value of at least \$1,000.

**Photo:** Each applicant must furnish a recent photograph, no smaller than 2" x 3". Picture should be enclosed in an envelope, and the envelope **must** be attached to the application. Do not staple or tape the photo directly to the application. Do not send Polaroid or instant photos. Photo should be identified with applicant's name typed on a label affixed to photo or written on back in soft pencil. These photos will be used for press releases only and will not be sent to evaluators or returned to applicants.

**References:** Each applicant must submit three letters of personal reference. References may be either typed or handwritten and should include the name, address, and daytime phone number of the person making the recommendation, as well as an indication of the person's relationship to the applicant (teacher, minister, employer, relative, etc.) References should indicate knowledge of applicant's character, determination to pursue a post-secondary education and any other factors, which will assist evaluation. One of these references must be a Vo-Ag Instructor, County Extension Educator, or 4-H Leader with whom the applicant has worked. References are to be placed in a plain white envelope and sealed. The individual writing the reference is to sign across the seal. The applicant's name must be written on the front of the envelope. The applicant must send the reference letters with his/her application.

**Documentation:** Each applicant must verify that he/she is enrolled in an accredited post-secondary educational institution. Submitting a copy of the current semester paid tuition, tuition plus room and board bill or acceptance letter will fulfill this requirement. The documentation must indicate that tuition has been paid and the amount paid.

**Deadline:** Application must be postmarked no later than <u>March 15, 2017</u>. Do not add additional pages; prioritize so that activities, etc. fit in the space provided.

**Evaluation Procedure:** For the purpose of evaluation of applicants, **selection committees** chosen by PLA will review all properly completed applications. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.** Applications submitted without the appropriate materials will be considered as incomplete and will not be accepted.

An evaluation sheet (p.11) will be used as part of the evaluation process for each application and scored individually on the basis of the criteria outlined in the eligibility section.

The recommendations of the scholarship evaluation committee will be referred to the PLA Scholarship Committee for final approval.

**Notification of Recipients:** Recipients of scholarship awards will be notified individually by the PLA Scholarship Committee. The scholarship will be presented at the KILE Opening Ceremony held in conjunction with the KILE Show.

\*\*Recipients are expected to be present at KILE to receive their award.

**Payment of Stipend:** Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the recipient, at the KILE Opening Ceremony.

Disclaimer: The PLA scholarship is separate from, and not related to either the KILE Beef Scholarship or the PA Farm Show Scholarship.
