

PENNSYLVANIA LIVESTOCK ASSOCIATION POST-SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited post-secondary educational institution they do NOT have to be pursuing a degree/certificate in an agriculture related degree/program.
 - o Not applicable for master's or Doctorate degrees
- Each scholarship will have a value of at least \$2,000.
- A student may receive the Pennsylvania Livestock Association (PLA) Post-Secondary Scholarship award one time only. (Previous PLA Outstanding 4-H/FFA Scholarship winners are eligible.)
- Application materials will not be returned and become the property of PLA Scholarship Committee.

Deadline: Application must be postmarked no later than <u>APRIL 15th</u>. Do not add additional pages; prioritize so that activities, etc. fit in the space provided.

Photo: Each applicant must furnish a recent photograph, digital preferred. Digital picture can be sent to <u>plasecretary@yahoo.com</u> with the applicant's name in the subject line. These photos will be used for press releases only and will not be sent to evaluators or returned to applicants.

References: Each applicant must submit two letters of personal reference. References may be either typed or handwritten and should include the name, address, and daytime phone number of the person making the recommendation, as well as an indication of the person's relationship to the applicant (teacher, minister, employer, relative, etc.) References should indicate knowledge of applicant's character, determination to pursue a post-secondary education and any other factors, which will assist evaluation. One of these references must be a Vo-Ag Instructor, County Extension Educator, or 4-H Leader with whom the applicant has worked. How to submit – 2 options

- Reference emails their letter directly to <u>plasecretary@yahoo.com</u> with the applicant's name in the subject line
- References are to be placed in a plain white envelope and sealed. The individual writing the reference is to sign across the seal. The applicant's name must be written on the front of the envelope. The applicant must send the reference letters with his/her application.

Documentation: Each applicant must verify that he/she is enrolled in an accredited post-secondary educational institution. Submitting a copy of the current semester paid tuition or tuition plus room and board bill will fulfill this requirement. The documentation must indicate that tuition has been paid and the amount paid.

Evaluation Procedure: For the purpose of evaluation of applicants, **selection committees** chosen by PLA will review all properly completed applications. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.** Applications submitted without the appropriate materials will be considered as incomplete and will not be accepted.

An evaluation sheet (p.11) will be used as part of the evaluation process for each application and scored individually on the basis of the criteria outlined in the eligibility section.

The recommendations of the scholarship evaluation committee will be referred to the PLA Scholarship Committee for final approval.

Notification of Recipients: Recipients of scholarship awards will be notified individually by the PLA Scholarship Committee. The scholarship will be presented at the KILE Opening Ceremony held in conjunction with the KILE Show.

Payment of Stipend: Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the recipient, at the KILE Opening Ceremony. **Recipients are expected to be present at KILE to receive their award.

Disclaimer: The PLA scholarship is separate from, and not related to either the KILE Beef Scholarship or the PA Farm Show Scholarship.
